A wonderful blend of modern and timeless. This New England Colonial boasts turn of the century details and space: hardwood and pine flooring, oversized windows, lovely room scale, rectangular and rounded bays, generous storage and three levels of living. Gracious entry hall opens to the sun-dappled living and dining rooms featuring natural wood moldings, pocket doors and a gas fireplace, both rooms hosting excellent ceiling height and large windows. These adjoining spaces create an open feel while still allowing delineated gathering spaces. The kitchen boasts granite counters, black/stainless appliances, tile backsplash and white cabinetry with generous preparation and dining areas. Bonus connections under one counter for future prep sink. Sliders allow access to the tiered deck, a perfect place to gather during good weather. The second level hosts four bedrooms, all well-sized, with a blend of wood flooring and full bath. The former master features a walk-in closet with the laundry area. The third level holds the master bedroom and adjoining bathroom with bonus storage area, creating a retreat space. The sellers have enhanced these spaces and maintained this home beautifully. Located on the cusp of Horace Mann, it's an easy jaunt to the train, the bus, the secondary school complex, Whole Foods, Highlands shops and restaurants, the Fells and Melrose's vibrant downtown.


